Concessions on Grounds

- Current Annual Negative Coggins Required (originals) and must be presented at the show grounds entry gate at every show.
- Every participant must sign a liability release form prior to showing at UCSC.
- No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs are allowed on the show grounds.
- Anyone exhibiting disruptive or inappropriate behavior will be asked to leave the show grounds .
- Unsportsmanlike conduct can result in loss of points earned daily / yearly and possibly be removed from the show grounds.
- The judges decisions are final; please show respect for their decisions at all times.
- Proper show attire required unless specified by the judge (refer to UCSC rule book).
- Helmets are required for all over fences classes or practice and 4-H designated classes.
- Beginner classes are those with 2 years or less riding experience (all ages). Beginners cannot enter into any other classes except Beginner classes, halter and showmanship .
- A pony will measure 14.2 and below. Shod ponies will have a ¼ inch shoe allowance. Measure all ponies prior to the first class of the first show attended. Points will not accrue until the measurement is registered at the Show Office.
- Scratches must be submitted on a "Scratch" form at least 2 classes in advance or the entry fee will be charged for the class!...NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Lunging of horses in the show arena must be completed by 1 hour prior to show time start.
- Classes with only 1 entry may be scratched or combined. Large classes will be split into heats based on show committee/judges discretion.

Year End Awards will be awarded as follows:** (all classes not marked with * will be counted toward year-end) In order to qualify for Year End Awards, you must exhibit your horse at a minimum of 4 shows during the year per division.

- Western – Champion & Reserve (Horse/Rider Pair) for Junior (12 & Under), Youth (13-18), and Adult (19 and over)
- English – Champion & Reserve (Horse/Rider Pair) for Junior (12 & Under), Youth (13-18), and Adult (19 and over)
- Pony – Champion & Reserve (Pony/Rider Pair) Measure prior to the first class of the first show attended. Points will not accrue until the measurement is registered at the Show Office.
- Halter – Champion & Reserve (Horse/Rider Pair) Points accrue from any halter class except Showmanship.
- Gaited – Champion & Reserve (Horse/Rider Pair)
- English Beginner – Champion & Reserve (Horse/Rider Pair)
- Western Beginner – Champion & Reserve (Horse/Rider Pair)
- Tot Leadline – Champions (Rider On Any Horse) – must show in Tot Lead Line Class a minimum of 4 classes.
- Visit web site for complete listing of qualifying classes for each division.

** Awards Subject to change if numbers warrant.
